ENTRIES & CLOSING DATE: Your entry must be RECEIVED by **May 25, 2015**. To be accepted, entries must be complete, signed (by parent or legal guardian if handler is a minor), received by the closing date, and accompanied by the correct fees made payable to **Pup 'N Iron**. You must file a separate entry form for each dog entered (i.e., only one dog per form).

Show Site and Food

Indoors; fully matted, 3/4" rubber. Several convenience stores and fast food facilities within 3 miles. On both Saturday and Sunday afternoon will be a potluck lunch so please bring a dish to share if you'd like to participate.

Directions:

From Points North: Take I-95 South to Exit 140 -Stafford Rt. 630. Make a left from exit ramp and go East on Rt. 630 (Courthouse Rd.) to the first traffic light. Turn right onto Rt. 1 South (Jefferson Davis Highway) and proceed 3.4 miles to Perchwood Drive. Turn left onto Perchwood Drive (Across from the Sports Booth) and make immediate left into first driveway. (United Transmission -mustard yellow building -will be on your right.) Follow that driveway all the way to the back to the cobble stone front building (21 Perchwood Drive). Pup 'N Iron is Unit 111, located directly behind the 7-11.

From Points South:

Take I-95 North to Exit 136-Stafford Airport/Centerport Pkwy. Follow the exit to the first stop sign. Make a right, following the signs for Route 1. At Rt. 1 make another right and go North. Proceed about 2 miles and make a right onto Perchwood Drive (Behind 7-11). Go to first driveway on the left and turn left. United Transmission (mustard yellow building) will be on your right. Pull all the way back to the parking lot in front of a set of stone front buildings. We are at 21 Perchwood Drive, Unit 111.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. A refund of all but \$5.00 will be given for bitches in season. A letter from your veterinarian is required by the first day of the Trial.
- All fees must be paid in US funds. There will be a Returned Check Fee of \$25.00 for returned checks.
- In the event of withdrawal from the event, checks will NOT be returned. All unused checks will be destroyed.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when using the warm-up area or in the agility ring.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the Trial.
- Exhibitors must clean up after their dogs at the hotel and at the Trial Site.
- Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not allowed to use whistles, clickers or other instruments or devices.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignias of their training group, if they wish.
- Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are PROHIBITED.

Obstacle Familiarization - obstacle familiarization will be held Saturday and Sunday 30 minutes prior to judging for dogs. Familiarization - one time per dog. **Any dog measuring over 17" MUST go thru obstacle familiarization.**

Warm-ups - a warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all Exhibitors.

Show site – Outside; dirt/grass surface; ring dimensions 60' x 60' ; whether equipment is rubberized and adheres to TDAA preferred specifications.}

Eligibility - this trial is open to all dogs **20-inches** and under at the withers that are over the age of 12 months, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

Move-Ups - Move-ups will be accepted until May 12th for dogs earning a title at a prior show. Move-up requests must be in writing but may be sent via e-mail. Move-ups will also be accepted if a dog completes a title during the running of this Trial. In such case, the Move-Up request must be made immediately upon posting of scores for the class in which the title was earned. "Move-up Request Form" is sent out later in premium and available on the Secretary's Table at show.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 3rd in each jump height of each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a Qualifying Score. Fast-Track dogs **are not** eligible for awards in classes through which they Fast-Track. FEO (For Exhibition Only) will be offered.

Judging Times: Judging will start at **9:00am on Saturday & Sunday.**

The following is a list of obstacles to be used: (All TDAA size):

A-frame (6'8" sides w/slats)	Weave Poles (20" centers)
Table (30" sides)	Closed (collapsed) Tunnel (18" opening)
Winged Jumps	Tire Jump (18" loop)
Open (pipe) Tunnel (16" loop)	Dog Walk (8' planks w/slats)
Teeter (8' plank) (w/out slats)	Jumps without wings

Height Divisions

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in any trial. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs that run in a height division higher than their measured division will be scored in the higher jump height division (ex: if your dog is measured into the 12" division and you jump 16" at a TDAA trial you will be competing with 16" dogs for placements). Dogs that run in a height division lower than their proper division will be eliminated. Exhibitors may always choose to enter For Exhibition Only and jump in a lower height division. Provisional dogs must be measured by a judge. To figure leg to shoulder ratio: Height from the elbow to the ground ÷ height at the withers = % (ratio). If that percentage is less than 50% and meets the height requirement then the dog can jump at the next lower height.

- 4" jump height: for dogs measuring 8" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 12 inches or less
- 8" jump height: for dogs measuring 12" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 15" or less
- 12" jump height: for dogs measuring 15" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 17" or less.
- 16" jump height: for dogs measuring 17" or less at the withers.

ALL DOGS WITHOUT A PERMANENT HEIGHT CARD MUST BE MEASURED PRIOR TO THE FIRST DAY OF COMPETING AT THIS TRIAL. ARRIVE EARLY ENOUGH TO ACCOMMODATE MEASURING.

CLASS INFORMATION

Standard Class

Beginner Agility - All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grand-fathering of titles from other organizations.

Intermediate Agility - Only dogs who have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Superior Agility - Only dogs who have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) shall be eligible for participation in this class. (Dogs who have earned the Teacup Superior Agile Dog (TSAD) are also eligible for this class.)

Games Classes

Games I - All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grand-fathering of titles from other organizations.

Games II - Only dogs who have earned the Games I (TG1) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games III - Only dogs who have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Dare to Double - Dare to Double is a simple dog's choice game, the dog will earn points for taking obstacles in the order and direction of the handler's choosing. The team has 50 seconds to accumulate as many points as possible. The game begins at the start line and ends at the table. To keep all points accumulated on course the team must get to the table before course time lapses. If the team fails to get to the table before time expires, it loses half its points.

Connect the Dots - This is a point accumulation game. The object is to collect points from dot to dot; dots being the contacts. The team will start and finish on the table. The table is not live until the dog is directed on it. No points are required to collect the first dot, but are encouraged. Each obstacle including the dots can only be performed twice for points overall. Each obstacle between dots may be performed only once for points. The dots need to have points in between in order for the dot to count.

Dealer's Choice - Dealer's choice is like a standard agility course and must be completed in numerical order. However the course contains options and are grouped together with the same number. The team must complete the course according to the numbers. All of number one followed by all of number two. It does not matter which obstacle is taken first in the group or which direction. No obstacle may be taken more than once unless faulted. The team must complete all obstacles with the same number before going on to the next.

Empire State Pinball Wizard - The purpose of Empire State Pinball is to accumulate as many points as possible in the time allotted. Big dogs (16" and 12") will have 45 seconds; small dogs (8" and 4") will have 50 seconds. All dogs start at Lincoln Tunnel, and finish on the Tilt (table).

Easter Egg Hunt - An assortment of colored plastic Easter eggs with a number marked on them, are placed in the 10 x 10 foot marked squares on each side of the course. The obstacles are set at random, with no designated sequence. Each obstacle is assigned a point value by the judge. The handler is given an Easter basket at the start of the run. When each obstacle is performed without fault by the dog, the handler earns the point value of that obstacle and picks up an egg from either 10 x 10 foot square, and places it in the basket. The team continues earning points picking up eggs by continuing to successfully perform obstacles.

Full House - The objective of Full House is to successfully accumulate required points and before the expiration of time gather the elements of the Full House: three-of-a-kind – 3 single bar jumps; twosome – 2 "circles" (tunnel, collapsed tunnel, or tire); Joker – 1 contact.point.

For Exhibition Only (FEO)

TDAA allows FEO runs open to any TDAA registered dog in any class; offered at the option of the host club. FEO dogs may run on lead. FEO runs do not count toward TDAA titles. No treats or food allowed. FEO will have a maximum of 1.5 times of the SCT. FEO cannot repeat any obstacles. No training in the ring.

Disabled Handlers: A time exemption will be granted to disabled handlers amounting to 4 seconds in Standard course times and in qualifying course times for Games classes.

PLEASE READ!!

How the Fast Track Move-Up Program Works

This may be grand-fathered from other organizations on a "Fast Track" basis. A dog with a higher title from another organization may move up on the same day to the next level of TDAA competition with a qualifying score. It is possible to move up from Beginner to Superior on the same day, if the dog qualifies first in Beginner, and then qualifies again in Intermediate. It is also possible to move up from Games I to Games III on the same day, if the dog qualifies first in Games I and then qualifies again in Games II enough points in Games I to qualify for Games III. A qualifying score in the lower class is required to move up to the next higher class. **You must submit a copy of title certificate for each dog.** Submit \$8.00 for each dog's move-up request. Payment of the \$8.00 is no guarantee that your dog will qualify at the lower level (though he will have multiple chances at each), and is non-refundable. This Fast Track fee must be paid for this trial, even if it was paid for a previous trial.

Entries

Entries close on May 25, 2015, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted. Day of Event Entries **WILL BE** accepted **up and until 8:45am on Saturday and Sunday** for \$16.00 per run. TDAA Dog Registration Numbers may be applied for at the event so that your dog can participate in this trial.

Entries will not be accepted without fees. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry forms. One dog per entry form.

Photocopied entries, without the signed TDAA Agreement attached are NOT acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the Trial. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for any returned check(s). Subsequent returned check(s) from the same Exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
